INSIGHTS ON THE HAGGADAH



<p>Why 4 Cups of Wine? Royal Butler Dreamin</p> <p>The Talmud Yerushalmi says the 4 cups of wine correspond to the times WINE is mentioned in the Pharaoh's Butler's recall of his own Dream in the story of Yosef in the Prison. But what does that have to do with Passover seder?</p> <p>Rabbi Kalatskin explains that the 4 cups of the Butler's dream, and dreams in general, reveal the ultimate hidden desire of the Butler to return and serve Pharaoh. It was what he wanted and his dream upon analysis emphasized his true intention. So to the cups of our seder should help us reveal our real intentions to be free to create the space to serve God as a nation</p>	<p>4 Sons: Dull the Teeth of the Wicked Son:</p> <p>The talmud explains that God doesn't consider evil intentions, only evil actions. So think what you like, but God holds all of us responsible only for our actions. Why is this? Rabbis explain that ultimately every human has a good soul that has pure intentions, and that despite having thoughts one way or another, who we truly are is not our thoughts.</p> <p>Rabbi Menachem Zemba says this is why we dull the teeth off the Wicked son, meaning we stop him while its only <i>mouth deep - it's only in thought</i>, there we put a full stop before anything results in wicked actions.</p>	<p>Laban the Aramean</p> <p>Lavan, not exactly the ideal candidate for Jewish People enemy #1. So why do we note him as the one who tried to "destroy everyone Jewish" ?</p> <p>R' Chaim Berlin says this paragraph is right after In Every Generation to ensure we know: Jewish enemies come in different forms. Some seek our explicit death to Jews (Nazis, Hamas) , but some of our enemies in history engage the Jewish people through a form of love with the absolut obsession for us to assimilate into nothingness.</p> <p>As Lavan offers in the Jacob "your daughters are my daughters, your sons are my sons". That enemy is a much harder one to identify and can be equally as dangerous</p>
<p>4 Cups of Wine VS. 3 Matzos: Thanksgiving Based Symbols</p> <p>Why are the 4 cups of wine and only 3 matzot? The Maharsha explains that they both symbolize the ways of gratitude in the Temple.</p> <p>The wine correspond to the 4 things we say Blessings of Thanks (Birchat HaGomel) after crossing dessert, sea, sickness recovery and prison release</p> <p>The 3 matzot correspond to the 3 types of breads brought in the Beit Hamikdash as the Thanksgiving offering.</p> <p>Rabbi Soloveitchik says all of the language of the haggadah is anchored in the prayer said when bringing the Bikkurim first fruits which was the real first Thanksgiving- which is critical to retelling the story of leaving Egypt: showing 100% gratitude</p>	<p>Where do we start this story?</p> <p>There is a famous argument recorded as to where we start the "Lowly Origin Story" of the Jewish People in the Haggadah.</p> <p>Does it start with our physical low of slavery story in Egypt, or is it farther back when Abraham was of a family of idol worshipping pagans?</p> <p>We mention both starts at the seder, but we underscore the start of mentioning Terach Abraham's idol worshipping father to underscore the resolve of our forefather, and to remind us that no matter what background you have, you too can connect to our Jewish origin story.</p>	<p>We Cried out, and the Lord Heard our Cries...</p> <p>At this point in the seder, it is actually recommended that everyone focus on their own aspirations and prayers at this point.</p> <p>Why did suddenly God listen in, the commentators note the word "gam" also heard. Who also was listening.</p> <p>The answer they give is that the Jewish people were the ones listening to each other's pains.</p> <p>The lesson here is that God starts to listen, once we listen to our nation's cries first. The merit of empathizing with another's pain is the actually the trigger for God to start listening in and actioning as well.</p>
<p>Ha Lachma Anya: Poorly Timed Invite:</p> <p>Why are we inviting people to come and eat while we are already sitting at the seder? While Rabbis explain that this is a symbolic gesture that, only freeman have the ability to invite others to join, R' Shmuel Dovid Wolken explains that this gesture reveals the opposite.</p> <p>At this point, we only have Poor Man's Bread in front of us, and yet we still invite others to join us, that really shows our true essence of always wanting to help and support others even when we barely have enough for ourselves.</p>	<p>End of Beginning</p> <p>Why is the Order Pesach Matzah Marror. If iti was sequential, the order would be Marror (Bitterness) Pesach (Exodus) Matzah (Freedom).</p> <p>The answer is buried in the paragraph that mentions Blessed Chishav et HKaytz - Blessed is the God who Considered the End of the slavery.</p> <p>Really the promise of God was for the Jews to be in Egypt 400 years, we were only enslaved for 210 years. Commentators note the intense suffering the Egyptians caused in the 210 years equated to being there for 400 years.</p> <p>So in actuality, the Bitterness (Marror) was the ultimate real cause of our eventual exodus, that is why we recite the order Pesach Matzah and Marror at the end</p>	<p>15 Stanzas of Dayenu</p> <p>Fifteen is always symbolic of transformation.</p> <p>15 Steps to the Temple</p> <p>15 days of the moon's climb to fullness</p> <p>Notice the following breakout of the Dayenu song:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first 5 stanzas are Egypt Theme • The second 5 stanzas are Desert Theme • The last 5 stanzas are Spiritual Theme <p>Illuminates the 3 phases of steps from Physical Slavery to Spiritual freedom</p>
<p>Leaving Egypt or Leaving From Egypt?</p> <p>The language used throughout the Haggadah is Yesiat Mitzrayim, which means leaving Egypt. The Satmar Rav asks why not use Yesiat MiMitzrayim. For example: plague of Darkness reversed "Let there be light", This gives new meaning to the arbitrary nature of each plague, and that in fact God was truly formulaic in the way in which he inflicted retribution upon the Egyptians (R Moshe Grussgott)
Dtash Adash Bachab	What is the point of this Acronym? To just remember the 10 plagues?	Rabbi Yehuda wasn't only accustomed to giving Acronyms but also to teach a lesson. <i>Dtzech</i> means Happiness, <i>Adash</i> means Beans, <i>BAchab</i> means Brother. Alluding to the monumental Red Lentil Soup Birthright deal that Jacob bought from his brother Esav. Despite hundreds of years of slavery, after the plagues, it was suddenly all worth it. Dayaynu	There are 15 stanzas in this song. The number 15 shows up a number of times in the Haggadah. Can you name where?	There are 15 steps to the Seder. There are 15 stanzas to Dayaynu. 15 actually has a deeper significance of transition. There are 15 generations between Abraham and Solomon. From a people starting to a people establishing a king and a temple. 15 always signifies transition. The seder is intended to do just that for you personally. We say Dayaynu for all 15 steps no matter how illogical (getting to Mt. Sinai and not receiving the torah, Dayaynu?) as every step is one holistic transition (Rabbi Alan Schwartz)

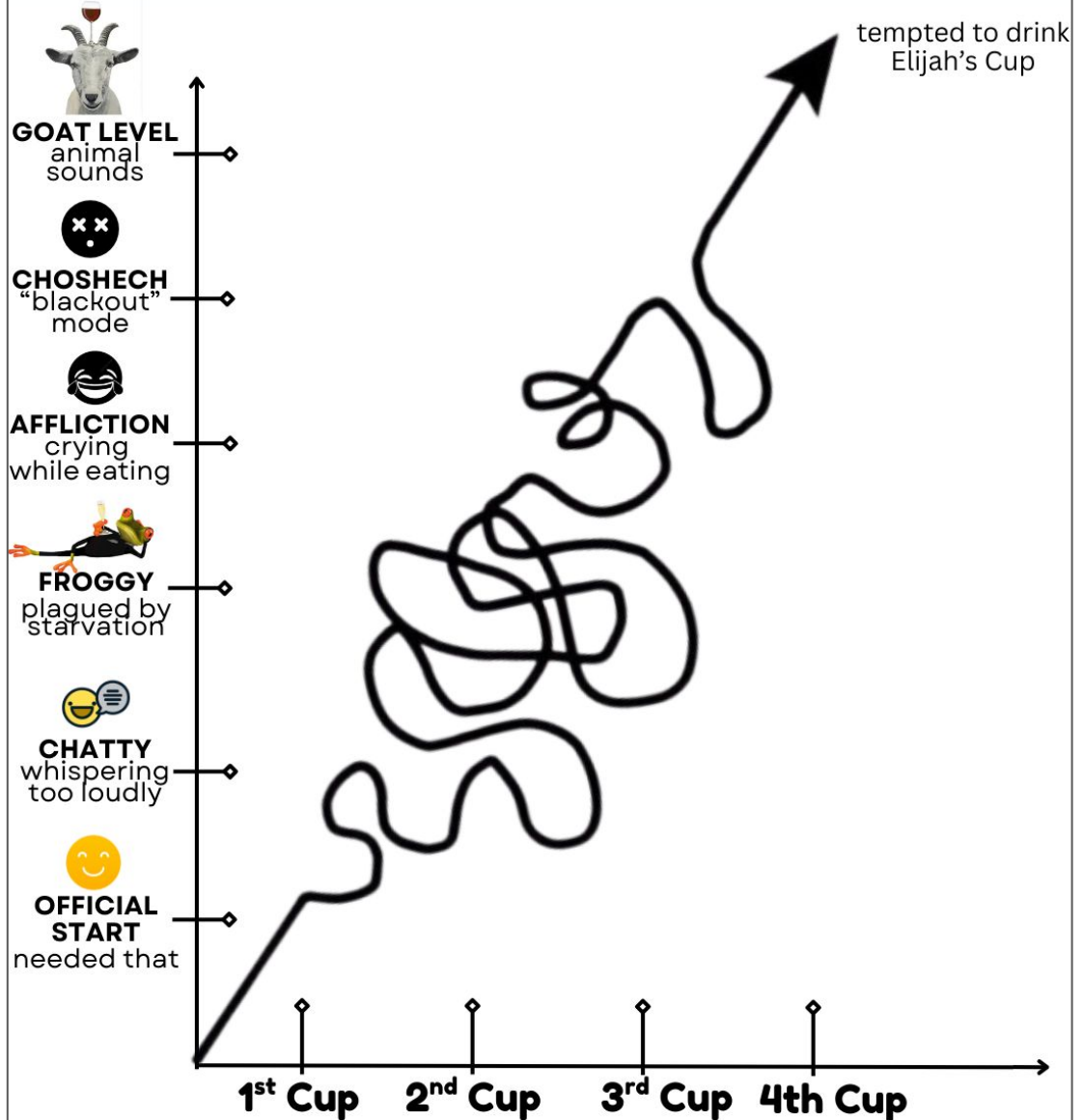

2. Why do we have a Seder plate, wouldn't it be more powerful to have an exodus map to trace every single strategic step of the Jews leaving Egypt?
3. Why don't we just read the Seder in synagogue? And if Passover is so successful at home, why not do all religious ceremonies in the house?
4. What is so important about freedom from slavery in Egypt that the Torah dictates to "Tell it to your children"?
5. Every time we say SHEMA we remember the exodus from Egypt, why now do we have one night dedicated to it?
6. There's a lot of the number 4? 4 questions, 4 sons, 4 cups. Why are there only 3 matzahs?
7. The AriZ"L (Rabbi Isaac Luria) said "Whoever is careful about avoiding even the slightest trace of chametz on pesach is assured he will not sin the entire year"
8. In all other holidays, saying Kiddush is never separated from the actual meal. How do we get away with it on Passover?
9. Are "Corny" jokes permissible on Passover or are they considered "kitniyot"?
10. Why do we call this Passover, Pesach if the Torah refers to these days as Chag Matzot (Matzah Holiday) – much easier!
